## II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A resident was arrested for assault in the 1500 block of Old Topanga Canyon Road. The suspect pointed a firearm at the victim (his wife) during an argument. (20-03855)

A residential burglary was reported in the 1500 block of Old Topanga Canyon Road. There were no signs of forced entry. When the victim arrived home during this incident, he saw his previous handyman exiting out of the balcony sliding glass door then jumped down onto the first floor and ran out of view. (20-03826)

A garage burglary occurred in the 21000 block of Waveview Drive. Suspect(s) unknown entered the attached garage via the left side garage door which was left open overnight. A bicycle and tools were stolen. (20-04207)

A residential burglary was reported in the 20300 block of Callon Drive. Entry was made via an unlocked door. Jewelry was stolen from inside the residence. (20-04201)

A resident of Woodland Hills was arrested for possession of a stolen vehicle. The vehicle was stolen from the 21300 block of Lighthill Drive. (20-04235)

A resident was arrested for assaulting (domestic violence) her boyfriend during an argument in the 1500 block of Valley Drive. (20-04075)

Two vehicle burglaries were reported in the 21700 block of Entrado Drive to the same vehicle. In the first incident, the front passenger window was smashed to gain entry and property stolen from inside. In the second incident, the victim had taped a garage bag over the smashed vehicle window to prevent any further damage or theft. Suspect(s) unknown made a hole in the center of the garage bag and stole a monitor from inside the vehicle. A cart was also stolen from the victim's driveway. (20-03755, 03756, 03757)

A vehicle burglary occurred in the 3100 block of Rossini Place. There were no signs of forced entry. Miscellaneous gift cards, a backpack, U.S. currency and medication were stolen from inside the vehicle. (20-04311)

A vehicle burglary was reported in the trailhead area of Topanga Canyon Road and Entrado Drive. The victim was hiking during the incident. There were no signs of forced entry into the vehicle. (20-04356)
