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## II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A residential burglary was reported in the 20500 block of Cheney Drive. A glass door was smashed to gain entry. (16-06357)

A residential burglary occurred in the 2100 block of North Topanga Canyon Blvd. Suspect(s) unknown made entry into the residence via an unlocked upstairs window. A locked outside storage shed was also entered and there were no signs of forced entry. The victim's three unlocked vehicles, parked in the driveway, were entered and property was taken. Property taken consisted of jewelry, numerous animal rescue tools, medical equipment and first aid kits. (16-06378)

A vehicle burglary (smashed window) and theft from an unlocked vehicle were reported in the 3100 block of Voltaire Drive. An amplifier and tools were taken. (16-06514, 06515)

A domestic violence incident was reported in the 900 block of Old Topanga Canyon Road. The suspect assaulted his girlfriend during an argument. The suspect left the location on foot prior to the deputies arrival. The case is on-going. (16-06344)

A vehicle burglary occurred in the 22000 block of Topanga School Road. The front passenger window was smashed to gain entry and a wallet with its contents was taken. (16-06512)


Two thefts from an unlocked vehicles were reported this month. The incidents were reported in the 3100 block Schweitzer Road and 800 block of Robinson Road. Jewelry, sunglasses, U.S. currency and a backpack were taken. (16-06069, 06647)

Three vehicle incidents occurred in the 19600 and 19700 blocks of Grand View Drive. Two incidents were vehicle burglaries where the vehicles windows were smashed to gain entry and one incident was a theft from an unlocked vehicle. Property taken consisted of a laptop, wallets, luggage, clothing, sunglasses and a purse. No suspect(s) seen or heard. (16-06516, 06521, 06576)

A theft of crystals (taken from a sculpture) was reported in the 19900 block of Sischo Drive. Suspect(s) unknown entered the victim's yard to commit the theft. (16-06305)
