II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

After the victim sent the twenty nine dollars, she began receiving phone calls from "sweepstakes" representatives. During the phone calls, the victim was instructed to send more money. It was later discovered that these representatives obtained the victim's bank account number, established an online account and withdrew monies from the account. (15-00819)

A theft from a safe (U.S. currency taken) occurred in the 1700 block of Topanga Skyline Drive. The victim believes the suspect is an ex-boyfriend. (15-00952)

A theft was reported in the 21400 block Lighthill Drive. The victim stated she received a phone call from an IRS agent who stated she owed monies to the IRS. He told her she could pay off her debt by buying "Reloadit" cards and calling him with the card numbers that would allow him to withdraw the funds. Suspect(s) unknown intentionally set a vehicle on fire in the area of Topanga Canyon Blvd and Entrada Road. The investigation is on-going. (15-01054)
