II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A residential burglary was reported in the 1000 block of Aztec Street. The victim was inside his bathroom when he heard a noise that sounded like footsteps near the kitchen area. The victim exited the bedroom to investigate and saw the suspect, a male adult, with a beard, wearing a dark hooded jacket and dark colored pants standing in the kitchen area. The suspect ran out the back kitchen door and jumped over the fence. Victim believed he heard footsteps on the roof of the residence too but did not see a second suspect. Entry was made via the back kitchen door that the victim had left wide open that night. No property was stolen. (19-04016)

A resident was arrested for residential burglary in the 800 block of Robinson Road. The victim pulled up the driveway of the location and saw that her front door was open and the kitchen, dining room and living room had been ransacked. The victim saw the suspect in the living room area consuming food. The suspect fled the location. The victim saw the suspect make entry into another residence near by. There were no signs of forced entry into the victim's residence. (19-04143)

A residential burglary occurred in the 27900 block of Portage Circle. A kitchen window was dislodged from its track to make entry. Victim stated no property was stolen. (19-03646)


A vehicle burglary was reported in the 20000 block of Entrada Road. The victim was hiking during the incident. The front passenger window had been smashed to gain entry. A purse, credit/debit cards and perfume were stolen. The victim received a text message from the bank regarding a fraudulent transaction that had been declined when unknown suspect(s) attempted to use one of the stolen debit cards. (19-03747)

A vehicle burglary occurred in the area of Fernwood Pacific Drive and Topanga Canyon Road. The rear passenger window was smashed and three laptops were stolen from the rear passenger seat. (19-04109)
