II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

Three residential burglaries have been reported at the same home on Saddle Peak Road. In one incident, three suspects, were arrested for entering the home. In another incident, there were no signs of forced entry and a safe was forced open to remove firearms. In the third incident, there were no signs of forced entry and three suspects were arrested. Two vehicles were stolen from this location also. One vehicle is still outstanding, and the other vehicle was recovered in the jurisdiction of the Los Angeles Police Department's West Valley Division. LA County Code Enforcement has been requested to assess the property for possible board up authorization as the property was partially abandoned. (23-00212, 00245, 00300, 00328, 00329).

A residential burglary occurred on North Topanga Canyon. The suspect, known to the victim, used the residence key left on the porch area to gain entry. (23-00038)

A residential burglary was reported on Van Allen Place. The second-floor bedroom window was smashed to gain entry. An attempt was made to open the safe in the closet. (23-00204)

A residential burglary occurred on North Topanga Canyon. This incident occurred in November 2022 but reported on January 2023. Entry was made into the victim's bedroom through the balcony sliding glass door which had no signs of forced entry. Property was stolen from inside the bedroom. (23-00286)

A commercial burglary was reported on South Topanga Canyon. The front glass door was smashed to make entry. Video footage showed three suspects. (23-00409)

A theft of a bicycle occurred on Entrado Drive. The bicycle was stolen from the carport area. (23-00313)

February 8, 2023

Two thefts of trailers were reported on Montau Drive. One trailer was stolen from the driveway and is still outstanding. Video footage on the other incident showed two suspects attempting to steal the other trailer from the driveway area. (23-00007, 00016)

A theft of a package occurred on Fernwood Pacific. The package contained coffee products. (23-00215)
